[4] The members discussed over the progress of teaching and implementation of new curriculum of B. Sc. I Sem-I, & II. Members also discussed the evaluation pattern of internal and end sem exams.

[5] Syllabus for Sem III and Sem IV for session 2017-18 was proposed. The members emphasized on incorporation of application and skill oriented part. Some applied topics were suggested. These will be incorporated in syllabus of 2017-18 in due course of time. Some less relevant topics are dropped.

The changes made to the syllabus are within the UGC's permissible limit of 20%.

[6] Scheme of Teaching, Evaluation and Examination was discussed and approved.

- [7] Proposal to start M.Sc. in Mathematics submitted to RTMNU was discussed.
- [8] The members expressed the need of transparency in the entire evaluation and examination process.
- [9] The members suggested that project supervisors/ co-supervisors may be selected from engineering / applied fields.
