Minutes of the BOS meeting held on 17/04/2021 at 11.00 am


The meeting of the board of studies in languages was held on 17/04/2021 at 11.00 am. in Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

Following members were present in this online meeting.

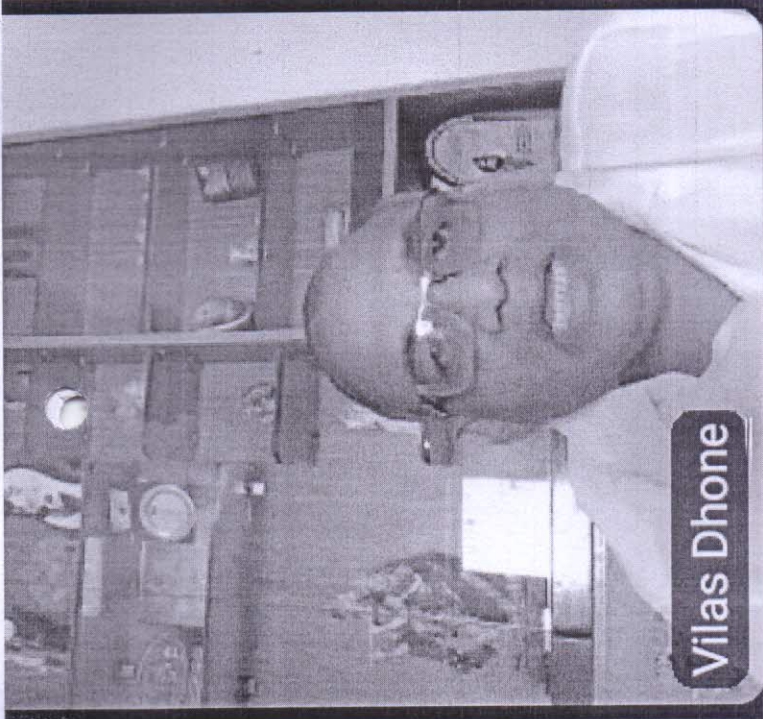

01. The minutes of the previous meeting dated 23/12/2020 were read, approved and confirmed.
02. Syllabus of B. Sc. Part I ( Compulsory and Supplementary English) was discussed at length.
03. Dr. S K Navin suggested that "The boy who broke the bank" in unit 1 may be replaced by "Rule of the road" by A. G. Gardiner.
04. Dr. V B Dhone suggested that "The elegy written in a country churchyard" may be replaced by "How much do I love thee" by Elizabeth Barret Browning.
05. The experts opined that there should be a separate text book for Compulsory & Supplementary English for autonomous colleges.
06. Shri R. K. Thombare putforth a technical difficulty that no publisher is ready to publish such a megre quantity book like 300 numbers.
07. Dr. Krishna Dixit suggested that material may be compiled from various sources, so we don't need a text book as such.
09. Dr. Dixit suggested that the items in unit 3 (Grammar) may be taught explicitly; instead, students should be taught word to sentence, sentence to paragraph, paragraph to text and text to discourse etc.
10. Dr. Dhone and Dr. Navin opined that Dr. Dixit's suggestions are not practically possible unless students are present in person in the classroom.
11. Shri. Rajesh Dambhare (Marathi) opined that we will implement the textbook "Sahitya setu" that has been implemented by RTM Nagpur University. Dr. Vinod Raut consented for the same.
12. Miss. Surekha Dube (Hindi) was absent for the meeting.
13. Miss. Urvi Gupta (meritorious alumna) was absent for the meeting.

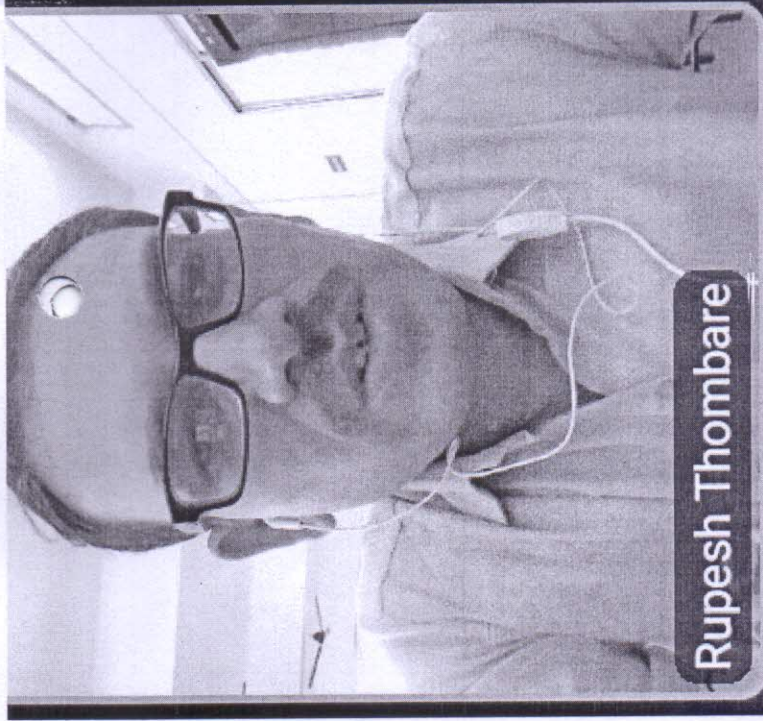
As there was no other matter in the agenda, the meeting came to an end.
