- 1) A new BOS was constituted from session 2020-21 onwards. Meeting started with the introduction of new members by the Chairman and their welcome by principal Dr. Om. Mahodaya.
- 2) BOS Chairman, Dr. Bagade gave a brief introduction about the Department of Physics and the various activities carried out in the department. The progress of the department during the last three years of autonomy were elaborated by him.
- 3) Dr. Tiple discussed the syllabus of sem-I to sem- VI which is in force. He also discussed the proposed changes that are to be made in the semester-I syllabus.

- 4) Dr. Smita Acharya suggested that skill based, capacity building syllabus involving computer programming should be introduced and field visits be conducted for students for better learning experience.
- 5) Shri. Ravikumar suggested that the syllabus be modified such that it should address the local issues as well as should develop students skills for industrial applications. Shri Ravikumar and Dr. Shyam Anwane stressed that students should have in-depth knowledge of the topics to facilitate their future progress and higher studies.
- 6) Minor changes in syllabus of B.Sc.I (sem I) were discussed and suggestions were received from the BOS members in this matter. This suggestion will be incorporated in the syllabus from session 2021-22, after further discussions in next BOS meeting, if necessary.
- 7) Question paper pattern for end semester exam of B.Sc., Evaluation and marking scheme and Panel of internal and external valuer were discussed by Dr. Lakhotiya and Dr. Yerpude. It was accepted by the members.
- 8) All the external and internal members of the BOS were of the opinion, that the present physics syllabus of one paper having six units was too bulky from students learning point of view and for the benefit of students it should be split into two papers each consisting of four units.
- 9) The meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks by prof. Jadhao.
