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## Action taken report on Feedback 2021-22

Feedback on the curriculum has been taken from students, teachers, and alumni. It is analysed by the feedback committee and the feedback is discussed in the common meetings and in the meeting of the College Development Committee dated May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The feedback is used for the development of the college as well as for the curriculum.

### Analysis of Students' Feedback

Students are the most important stakeholders in the higher education system. For academic year 2021–22, feedback from our undergraduate and postgraduate students has been collected and analyzed. The report is as follows: With the current curriculum designed by Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, 22.32 % students are excellent, 34.74 % are very good, 34.28 % are good, 17.62 % are average, and 1.77 % are below average. For Postgraduates, on an average, 28.98 students are in the favour of excellent, 39.13 % are very good, 26.28 % are good, 4.87 % are average, and 0.78 % are below average with the current curriculum designed by Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

It has been informed to the committee that the reason why it has been ranked below average has not been mentioned by the students.

Student representative Ms. Shruti Dhopate has been asked for her opinion. She expressed the curriculum is excellent in her view.

### Analysis of Teachers' Feedback

Feedback from undergraduate and postgraduate teachers has been collected and analyzed. The report is as follows: the objectives of syllabi are well defined. 44.8 % strongly agree. 55.2 % agree.

### Analysis of Alumni Feedback

The feedback of the alumni is essential for the improvement and improvement of the higher education system. The Alumni Committee of the college has collected curriculum feedback using an online platform. A questionnaire has been designed to seek feedback from alumni to collect their opinion regarding the quality of academic environment of the college. The feedback committee analysed the feedback and it is discussed in the common meetings. The report is as follows: Alumni marked the curriculum with 23.5 % excellent, 63.01 % good, 10.05 % average & 3.34 % below average. It has been decided that the issue of improving the syllabus should be discussed with alumni in the respective BOS of the departments.

### **Analysis of Students' feedback using student satisfaction survey**


The student satisfaction survey (hereafter SSS) is a vital tool for gauging how satisfied current and prospective college students are with the college's resources and services. It is a trustworthy method for identifying promising regions for development. To that end, it sheds light on which sectors need more funding and attention. As such, it serves as a practical and straightforward measure of the quality of instruction offered. The college hopes that its students would get involved with SSS on a regular basis.

More than 70% of students reported 100% completion of the BSc syllabus with the current curriculum designed by Bajaj College of Science, Wardha. Seventy percent of students expressed thorough preparation by the faculty for most of the syllabus in the form of classroom lectures and practicals. Approximately half of students stated that internships, training, field trips, and institutional trips are all heavily promoted by the college. About 70 percent of students feel that their learning process through teaching methods is very good. More than 80% of students reported having access to a good library, teaching rooms, laboratories, and well-maintained equipment for practicals and project work. They found green campuses and eco-friendly, with good parking areas and quality playgrounds.

Ms. Shruti also expressed that the teaching and library facilities of the college are excellent and all other college facilities are satisfactory. She has been informed that, as per her representation about competitive classes, it has been conveyed to all the departments and they have been asked to plan for it. Accordingly, classes for competitive examinations will be planned and executed in the coming session. Due to COVID-19 in the last two years student's annual function could not be organized hence Students demanded more cultural and extracurricular activities in the college campus. It was noted by the committee and asked college to conduct regularly from the coming years.
