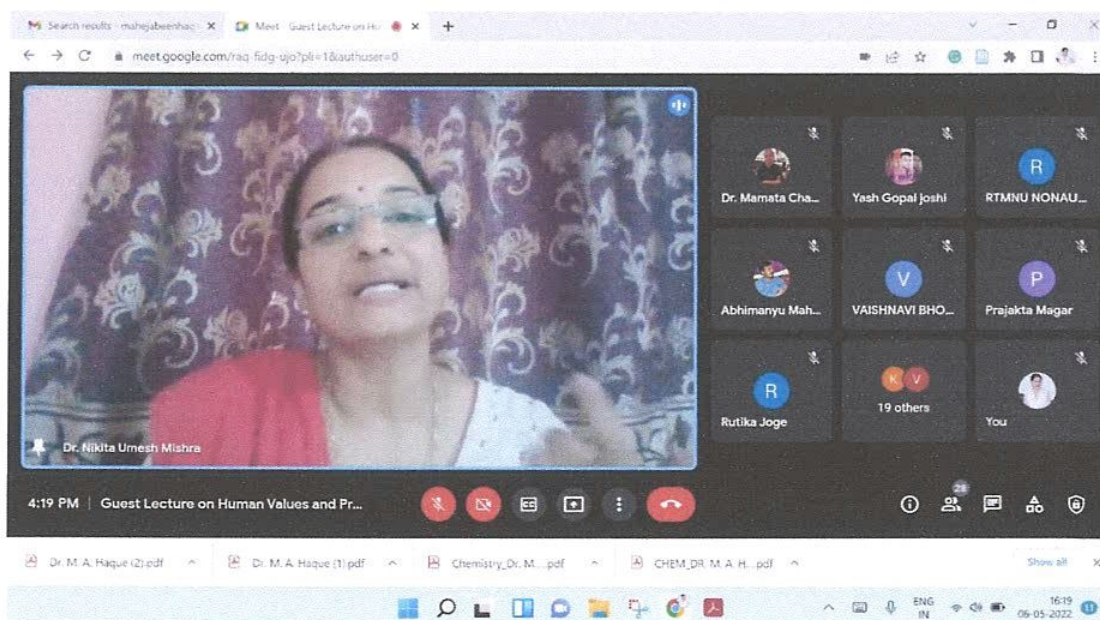

National Voters Day

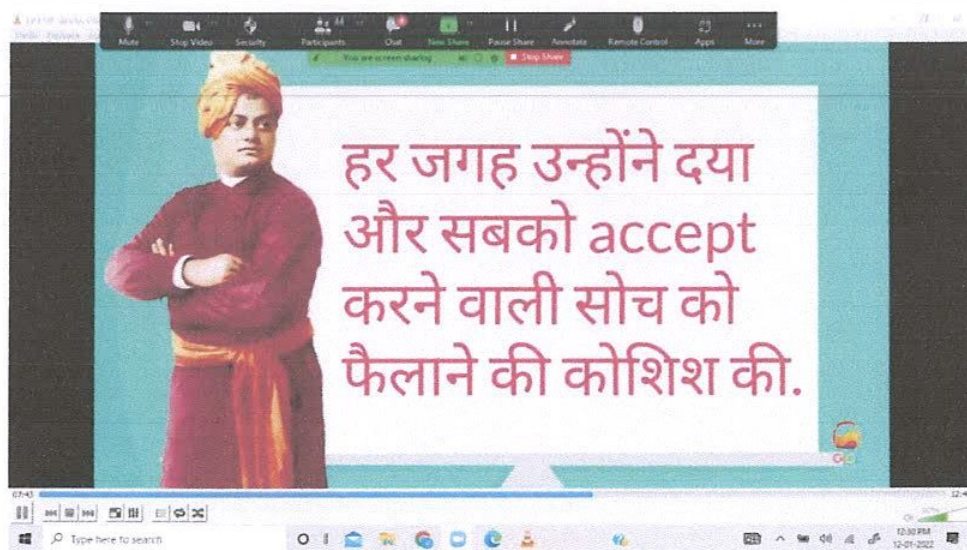

International AIDS Day

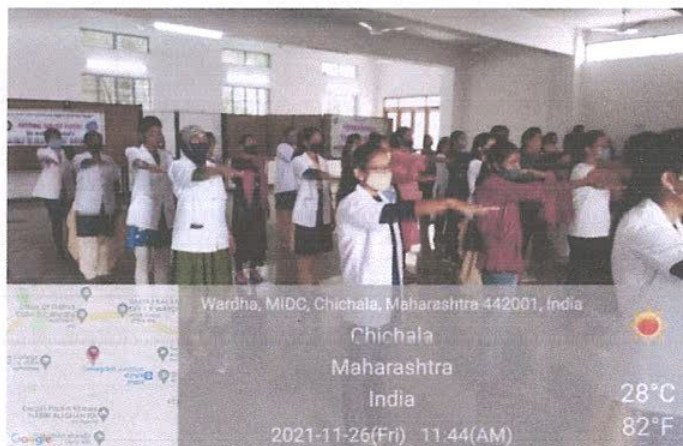

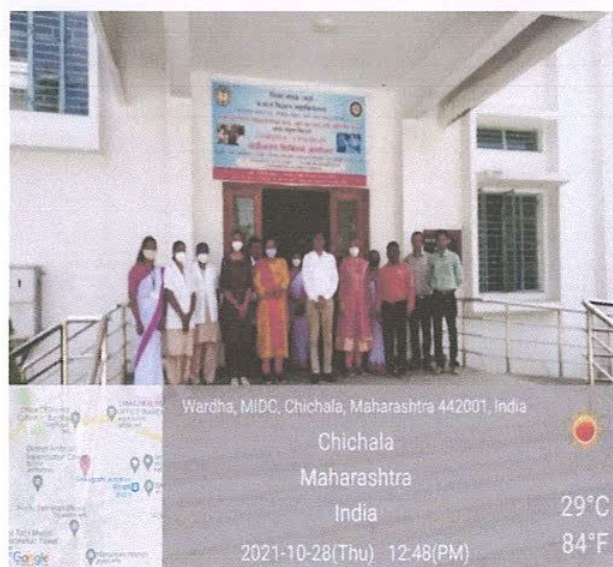
