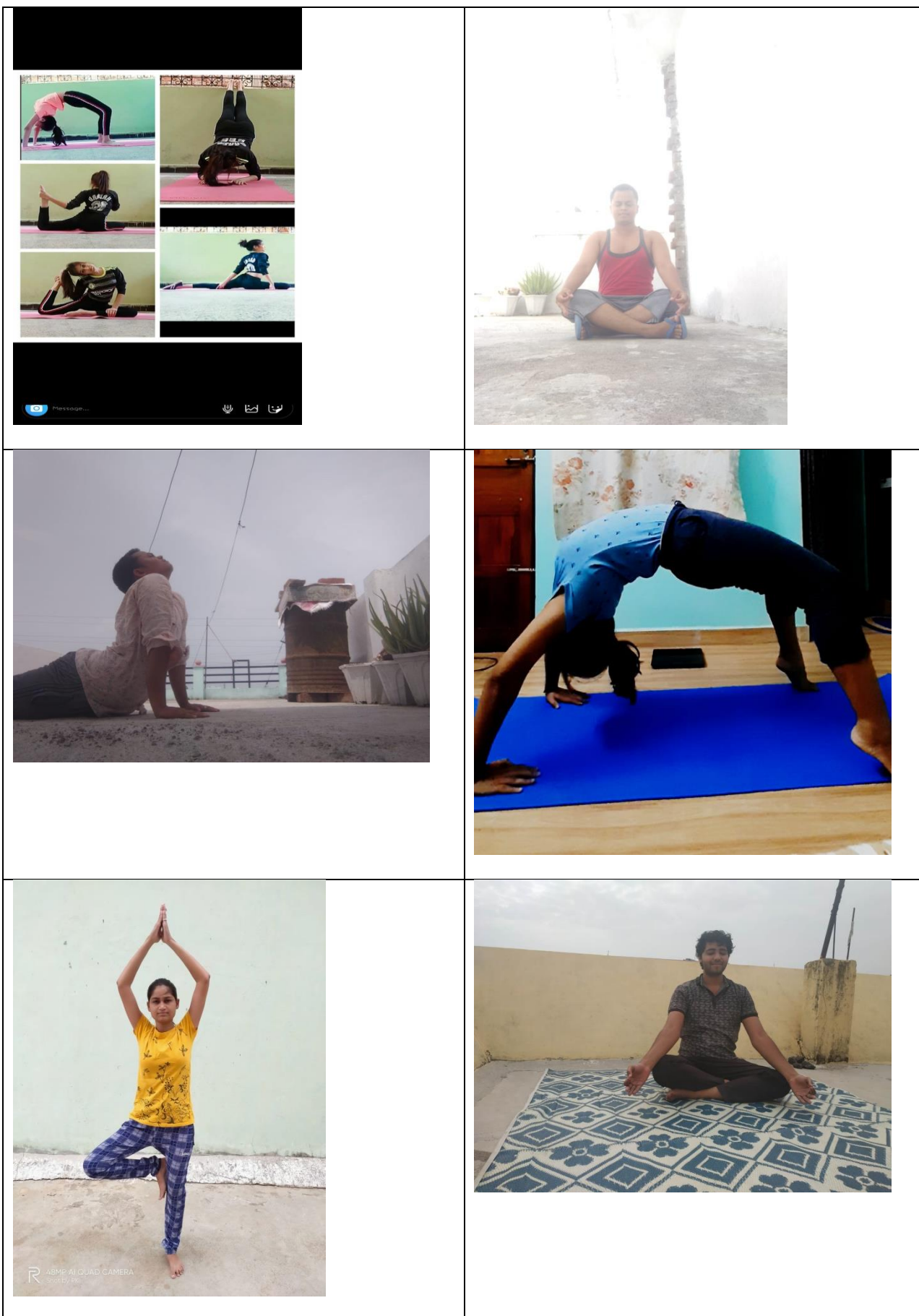
Regular Activities :

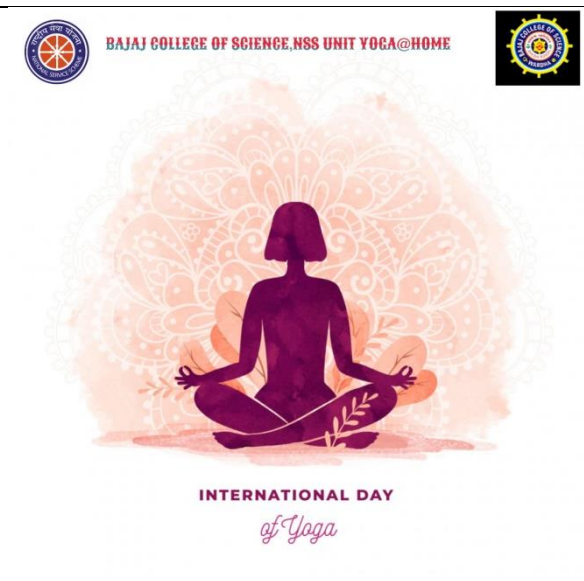
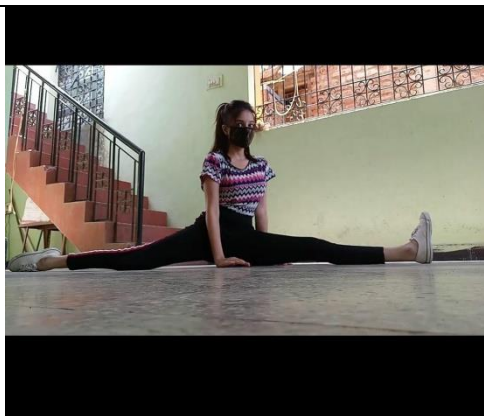

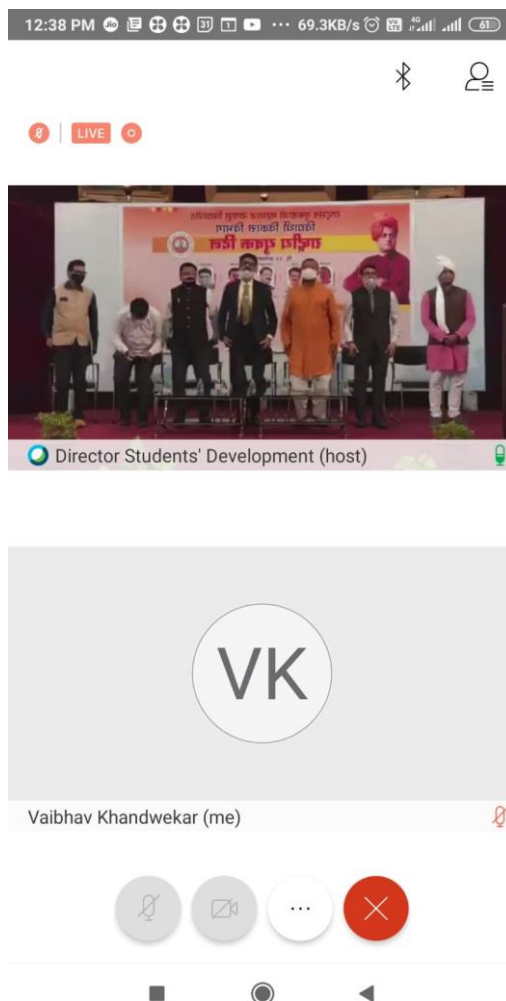






**RTMNU organised online National youth day on behalf of Swami Vivekananda Jayanti on 12<sup>th</sup> Jan2021 noon 12:00 :**
