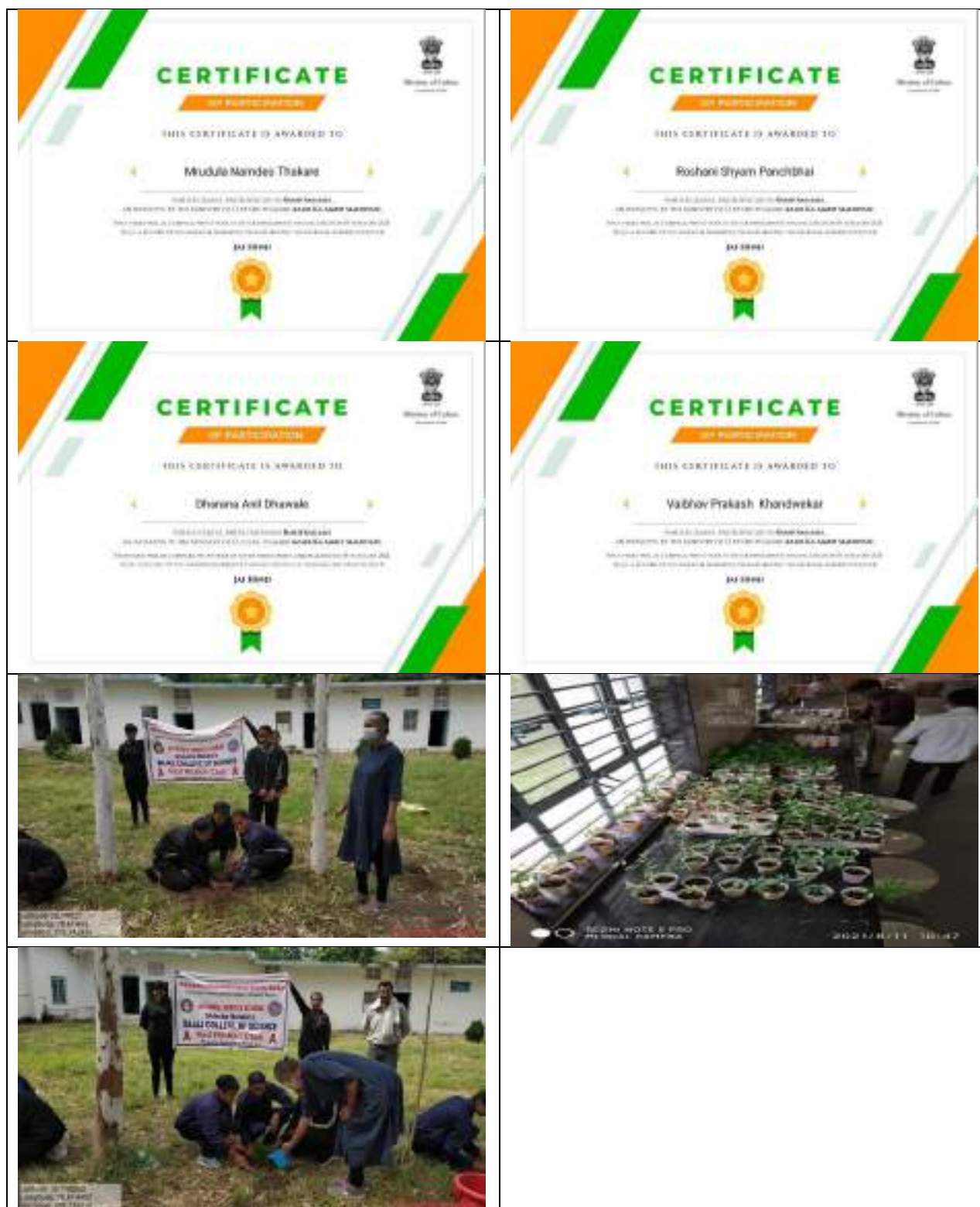












## Quiz Competition

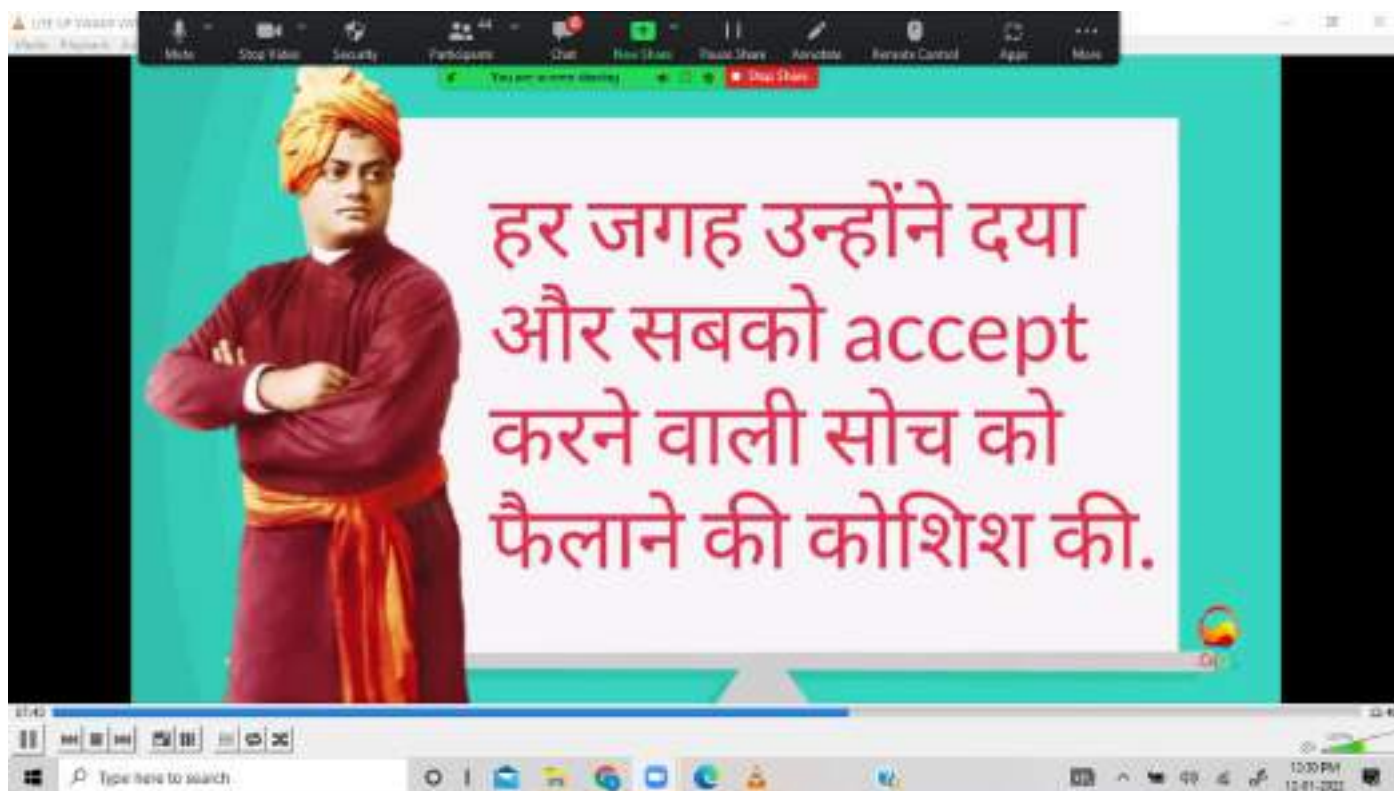
