By survey, it was observed that many people of Sonegaon (Bai) were well aware about the importance of toilets for health and around 80% families found to possess their own toilets. 20% families who were lacking this facility were keen to build toilets but due to unavailability of own land, they could not able to move in this direction. To resolve this issue, NSS unit with Sarpanch Sonegaon (Bai) & villagers organized a meeting with ZP officers at Wardha. Outcome of this meeting was fruitful and ZP officers resolved this issue by constructing the public toilets for needy family.
