

- If the idea is at initial stage and need all the developmental support the terms and conditions will be finalized at that time.
- 19. In case of any dispute arising in connection with this agreement or its interpretation or breach of any stipulations, except as hereinbefore provided, then the parties hereto shall endeavour to settle it through mutual discussions. If the disputes is not settled with mutual discussions, then any of the party or both parties, shall refer the matter to the Board of Directors, INCUBEIN FOUNDATION who shall decide the matter, at the earliest, and in any case within 45 (forty five) days from the date of any party approaching, with his written grievances to the Director, Incubein for referring the matter to the BOD, and whose decision shall be binding on the parties. If any of the party is not satisfied with the decision of the BOD or such named officer, or officer is unable to take up the matter or decide the matter, within said time or say within extended reasonable time, (if both parties agree for such extended time) then any of the aggrieved party, may resort to the arbitration, as hereinafter provided.
- 20. Any of the parties, being aggrieved by the final decision (or inaction to decide the matter in stipulated time or extended time) of Board of Directors of the INCUBEIN, for appointment an Arbitrator. The Board shall, having due regard to the nature of the dispute, amount involved, expertise required for resolving the dispute and other incidental issue, shall appoint a suitable person as an arbitrator. Such arbitrator can be in-house person or an outsider or can be an advocate or retired judicial officer or bureaucrat or Banker or IT expert, Financial expert or Company Law Expert or relevant expert in the field of the subject of dispute or any other person in the opinion of the Board who is a fit person to act as an arbitrator and expeditiously resolve the matter.
  - Arbitration Proceedings shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitrator shall be required to pass reasoned and speaking award. The Proceedings shall be in English and it shall be held at Nagpur. The cost of arbitration shall be shared equally by the parties.
- 21. The SUB-CENTERS shall not carry out any activity which is of unbecoming of the interest of the INCBUBEIN or RTMNU or which is prejudicial to the interest of the INCUBEIN in the opinion of INCBUEIN/RTMNU. The decision made by the INCBUEIN will final if any dispute arises.
- 22. The legal expenses for drawing up of agreements shall be borne by the SUB-CENTERS.

### TERM AND TERMINATION

- This Agreement shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for One Year, ("Full Term").
- b) Sub-Centers will pay the processing fee of Rs. 1000/- (One thousand) by DD or Cheque payable to INCUBEIN FOUNDATION for establishment of Sub-Center.
- This agreement may be further extended by mutual consent in writing (Depending on the growth of Center reviewed by team of Incubein)
- d) THIS agreement shall remain in force as mentioned herein above. It shall be open for either party to terminate this agreement by giving one month's written notice, without assigning any reasons. However, any termination of the agreement shall not absolve the SUB-CETNERS and its promoters of its liability incurred under this agreement. Without prejudice to anything stated, the INCUBEIN may terminate the SUB-CENTERS with immediate effect, in the event of the INCBUEIN loses its



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made on this day of the month of Accessal sin the year 2021 by and between Mahatma Gandhi Institute for Rural Industrialization (MGIRI), Wardha having its Head Office at Wardha [hereinafter called "MGIRI"/First party], a national institute under the Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India on the ONE PART and the Bajaj College of Science [Private minority Institution having its headquarters at Wardha [hereinafter called "BCS"/Second party], a constituent college of the trust "Shiksha Mandal", Wardha on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties).

The parties, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for promotion of students' training and quality postgraduate research in cutting edge areas

WHEREAS the "First Party" is a nodal institute to undertake lead researches in the area of product, process, technology development in rural industrialization (specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions). AND WHEREAS the "Second Party", established as a college and recognized by University Grants Commission and its Departments are involved in teaching in graduate and post graduate level in science such as physics, chemistry, bioscience, mathematics and research leading to doctoral degree in science subjects mentioned above (specific areas of research), affiliated to STM Nagpur University, Nagpur.

AND WHEREAS it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring expertise and logistics from both the parties.

- 1.1 The Second party will recognize the First party as an Institute for cooducting research related to the thesis requirement of the research students for M.Sc and Ph. D (Science) (Name of the degree programme). The Second party will recognize Scientists of the MGIRI Institute as recommended by its Director in accordance with the University rules and regulations for guiding students working for the said degree.
- 1.2 Operational details of research effort and collaboration will be made in common research programmes and/or projects restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions. The objective(s) for research work for a student coming from a Second party should be exclusively different as far as possible.
- 1.3 Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculty and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables will be borne by the respective organizations.
- 1.4 There shall be an exchange of students for academic, research and training purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.

### Article 2. Management

- 2.1 Director of the First party and the Head of the Institution of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU
- 2.2 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to the students, faculty and scientists.

### Article 3. Exchange of Information

3.1. The term "information" includes scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged, or arising under project descriptions entered into pursuant to this MoU.

3.2. The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint projects shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information for any and all purposes.

- 4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.
- 4.2 Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.
- 4.3 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the First party and the Second party.
- 4.4 (i) Any research publications arising will be jointly published. The student would invariably be the senior author for the publications arising out of the research work conducted at the institute followed by Major Guide/Advisor and Co-Major Advisor/Co-Guide in that order. The names of additional co-authors, depending upon their contribution in the research work, may be decided by mutual consent between the student and Major Guide/ Advisor. (ii) The partnering institutions may ensure that the institute should ensure that the student submits atleast one paper from Master's dissertation and two papers from Ph. D. thesis before dissertation / thesis submission in order to prevent students leaving the institute(s) without any research publication from the dissertation / thesis.
- 4.5 A copy of the thesis/dissertation will be submitted to the First Party after the award of the degree by the Second party.
- 4.6 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.
- 4.7 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual

4.8 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the parties.

SHOUTH CONTROL

5.1 The Second party will be expected to ensure protection of the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during the student's research work. The MGIRI as the first applicant (for its institute) and the Second party shall be the joint applicants for IPRs and the students and involved scientific staff shall be included as the inventor/author. The

management and benefits sharing of the generated intellectual property shall be mutually decided in each case.

# Article 6. Admission and Fees

- 6.1 All those who wish to register as trainees or for Master/Doctoral programme under this MoU must apply for admission at the Second party. The criterion for allocation of Major Guide / Advisor will primarily be governed by the intellectual input and time duration devoted for carrying out the research work at a particular institution. It may be decided by the mutual consent, keeping in view the MOU signed between partnering institutions. If the major guide is from MGIRI, the co-guide will be from partnering institute and vice-
- 6.2 Admission of the students and the award of degrees for different programmes will be the responsibility of the Second party as per the rules and regulations.
- 6.3 Allotment of the students at the First party will be done by the approval of Director of the First party and Head of the Institution of the Second party.
- 6.4 The First party would have the right to screen the student's eligibility for admission based on their academic period.
- 6.5 The number of student(s) at any particular time will be subjected to the availability of research facilities and scientists' time to guide thesis research at the First party institution.
- 6.6 Any student(s) admitted to the First party for training/postgraduate research, if found violating the rules and regulations laid down by the First party or indulge in such activities that amount to tarnishing the image of the Institute, or cause damage to the property, the registration of such student(s) would be summarily terminated. The Second party will not complete the formalities of issuing the certificates to such students until they compensate the losses to the First party.

6.7 Fees will be charged from the students by the First party as per as per the mutually agreed consent.

Article 7. Entry into effect, modification and termination Baja College Of Science;

- 7.1. This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three years extendable up to five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each three/five year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. 

Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, the Second Party, and represented herein by its Principal, Dr. O. A. Mahodaya, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", institute which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

### WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institutionnamed:
  - (i) Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Wardha
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;.
- E) Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, the Second Party, is engaged in imparting education in biotechnology and microbiology in addition to basic sciences like chemistry, zoology and Botany.
- Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, the Second Party, is promoted by the Principal;

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

# CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in Formulation of different formulations, preclinical studies in animals, safety studies in animals, pharmacological evaluation of drugs, keeping in mind the needs of the Second Party.

- 2.8 There is no financial commitment on the part of the Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Wardha, the First Party and Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, the Second Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealf separately between first party and second party and the decision will be binding on both the parties.

### CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to knowhow, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, the Second Party, after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in

writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

## CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

# Article 1. Scope

The areas of cooperation can be extended through mutual consent.

# ARTICLE-II: SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

Both BCS and Cleanchem Laboratories shall encourage interactions between the Scientists, Research fellows, faculty members and students of both the organizations through the following arrangements:

- a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars;
- Joint guidance of student projects / thesis in Chemistry and other areas of national interest at BCS by Cleanchem Laboratories on mutually agreeable terms.
- d) Cleanchem laboratory would accommodate meritorious students of BSc. Sem.VI & MSc. Sem.-IV (with chemistry subject) for the purpose of imparting industrial training.
- e) Cleanchem laboratories may depute its personnel as visiting faculty at BCS to teach any
  of the regular Course or specialized topics.
- f) Cleanchem laboratories personnel, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enroll for their Ph.D. / M.Tech. (Research) at BCS, subject to availability of seats, research facilities and subject to their fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of BCS and RTM Nagpur University Nagpur. Further, Cleanchem laboratories may request to design and teach a Course or Courses which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees. Such Courses maybe run at any mutually convenient premises.
- g) Cleanchem laboratories may seek assistance / guidance of BCS faculty members in product / process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, etc.
- h) Would allow the industrial visits of students for half / full day to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instrument, etc.
- Cleanchem laboratories may showcase its business activities at the seminar / workshop / conference, etc. at BCS.
- Cleanchem laboratories may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at BCS.
- k) Post-graduate student will be allotted a Research supervisor from BCS faculty members. A Research Scientist / Engineer at Cleanchem laboratories may be appointed a Coresearch guide as per the rules of the respective institute for a student Registered for Ph.D. / M.Sc. (Regular or Research) degree at BCS. The student maybe encouraged to

- take up the project such that Cleanchem laboratories desirably benefits from its outcomes.
- The students will carry out part of their Ph.D. research work or M.Sc. project at BCS and Cleanchem laboratories depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective institute depending on facilities and requirements.
- m) There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that no Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.
- Both BCS and Cleanchem laboratories will be free to independently carry out follow-up research on the thesis work conducted under this scheme.
- o) If the outcome of a project related to product development, process technology and design etc. which involves matter of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication / printing in any form such as Electronically / verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc by the parties under the law will be decided on case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- p) Research supervisors from both the Institutes will be the corresponding authors in any publication resulting from the collaborative work. All the efforts put by the student/s as a part of this MoU will be accounted for by way of reporting the work in thesis and/or paper publication except the part for which IPR needs be claimed.
- q) Neither of the supervisors will publish the work carried out under this MoU without knowledge of the other.
- r) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spell out clearly before starting the activity.

# ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a) BCS and Cleanchem laboratories shall make provisions to share their respective important R&D facilities in order to promote academic and research interaction in the areas of cooperation.
- b) BCS and Cleanchem laboratories shall permit the sharing software and other materials and components developed in-house in the areas of cooperation, if permissible within the rules governing the two institutions. However, responsibility for safety of software and other materials during the exchange will rest on respective Head of academic department / section.
- c) BCS and Cleanchem laboratories shall provide access to the library facilities to scientists, members of faculty and students as per the prevailing rules and norms in the respective institutes.

# ARTICLE-IV: CO-ORDINATION OF THE PROGRAMME INCLUDING

# FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- a) The collaborative programme between BCS and Cleanchem Laboratories shall be coordinated by a coordination committee appointed by Directors of both the Institutes.
- b) Financial arrangements for each specific collaboration will be decided on a case-to-case basis and brought on record in each case after due approval from heads of both the Institutions.

# ARTICLE-V: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- a) This MOU shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of 2 years from the effective date.
- e) During its tenancy, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than two months by either party. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students / faculty / scientists who have been admitted to pursue a programme under the MOU.
- d) Any clause or article of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of Cleanchem laboratory and BCS.

# ARTICLE-VI: IPR

a) Rights regarding publications, patents, royalty, ownership of software / design / product developed etc. under the scope of this MOU, shall be decided by the two parties by mutual consent.

# ARTICLE-VII: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenure of the MOU both BCS and Cleanchem laboratory will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MOU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MOU.

Both BCS and Cleanchem laboratory shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this agreement or PROJECTS.

Further both BCS and Cleanchem laboratory shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use.

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION shall mean any proprietary information, data or facts belonging to PARTIES collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any

other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions. However confidential information shall not include any data or information which:

- is independently developed by the receiving party without reference to the confidential information of the disclosing party
- d) is rightfully obtained by the receiving party from a third party or is in the public domain
- e) is disclosed with the written consent of the party whose information it is, or
- f) is disclosed pursuant to court order or other legal compulsion, after providing prior notice to the disclosing party.

# ARTICLE-VIII: AMENDMENTS

The arbitration proceedings shall be held in accordance with the provision of Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation ACT, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be New Delhi and Language of arbitration shall be English.

- a) The headings and sub-headings are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect the construction of this Agreement.

Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment This MoU will initiate upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for five years. This MoU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partner institutions. If either partner institutions wishes to terminate the MoU at the end of five years period it must be notify the other institution not less than three months prior to the expiry of the MoU. This MoU or its renewal and the action taken under it may be reviewed at any time. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Agreement shall deemed to be entered on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2018, between "J. B. College of Science, Wardha" (hereinafter referred to as "partnering institute"), which expression shall unless redugnant to the context shall deem to include its successors and assigns on one part.

and

Ed¶L (India) Limited (Implementing partner), a registered Mini Ratna Cateogry-1, CPSE set up under Companies Act, 1956 under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, having its Registered office at Vijaya Building, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, 17- Barakhamba Road, New Delhi-110001 and Corporate office at EdCIL (India) Limited House No. 18-A, Sector 16- A, NO¶DA-201301 (UP), which expression shall unless repugnant to the Contract, shall deem to



include its successors/ subsidiary/ ventures and assigns, hereinafter referred to as "EdCIL (India) Limited" on the other part.

#### 1. BACKGROUND OF STUDY IN INDIA PROGRAMME:

To have a rapid increase in the number of inbound overseas students into India in the next five years, a "Study in India" programme has been approved by SFC, MHRD on 15.03.2018. EdCIL (india) Limited has been nominated by the Ministry of HRD to be the implementation partner for its execution. The programme aims to increase the inflow of inbound international students through systematic brand-building, marketing, social media and digital marketing campaigns.

Participation in "Study in India" programme is a voluntary exercise wherein the "Partnering institutes" are required to commit seats (out of their total seats) and fee waivers for overseas students in the portal being created by EdCIL on behalf of Ministry of HRD.

#### 2. DEFINITIONS

- (i) "Partnering institute" means the institute shortlisted by EdCIL on the basis of NIRF( National Institute Ranking Framework) (IR 2017) /NAAC(National Assessment and Accreditation Council) rating or any other criteria as approved by MHRD.
- (ii) "EdCIL (INDIA) Limited" means "Study in India" team of EdCIL (INDIA) Ltd.
- (iii) "SII" means the Study In India Programme of the MHRD, Government of India.

### 3. OBLIGATIONS OF "PARTNERING INSTITUTES"

- a. Partnering Institute would be required to offer admission based on the selection of overseas candidates made through the counseling process on central admission portal and should not deny admission with or without committed fee waivers to the student. SII will roll out a conditional admission letter stating the terms of admission. Final admission would be subject to document verification.
- b. In addition to the above, in any rare circumstance, if another round of "virtual interview" is required, the same would have to be intimated in advance to EdCIL for being categorically mentioned in the conditional admission letter.



- c. Partnering Institute should provide an International hostel and a dedicated fully functional International student affairs office for the foreign students and should have supporting facilities for on-boarding of students and their engagement throughout the stay. They would also be open to introducing any overseas student friendly facilities as may be mutually agreed with EdCIL.
- d. The institute should provide the fee waivers as committed by them on the central portal www.studyinindia.gov.in
- e. Institutes should arrange the "mentorship programme" like assigning buddles to each of the student admitted through the central portal.
- f. If in case the FRRO(Foreigner Regional Registration Offices) verification is delegated to the institutes, partnering institutes should be willing to act as a local FRRO office for the foreign students.
- g. All the responsibilities of verification of certificates/marksheets etc of the prospective student would lie with the institution. Marks conversion/Equivalence criteria/Mutual recognition of courses would also be a responsibility of the partnering institute.
- h. Institute should provide updated information to EdCIL (India) Limited regarding students final admission through the portal as and when the facility is provided on the portal.
- Data transferred/ collected by the institute is their responsibility.

### 4. OBLIGATIONS OF EdCIL (India) LIMITED

- EdCIL shall on behalf of MHRD provide a fully functional/operational central portal www.studyinindia.gov.in
- EdCIL shall ensure proper allocation/merit based allocation on the basis of the academic performance and choice filling of the student on the central portal.
- c. EdCIL shall take care of the aggregated branding, social media and other media for the programme which may/may not include the details of the Partnering institute.
- d. EdCIL shall organize periodical fairs/seminar/workshops/participation in events which may/may not have a subsidy element. A fair chance of participation may be given to each of the partnering institute on the basis of decided parameter.



- e. Set up of Domestic/International facilitation centre as may be deemed fit.
- EdCIL would undertake any other activity (as approved by MHRD) and which aims to increase the number of foreign students in India.

### 5. VALIDITY OF THIS AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall deemed to be effective from 1st April, 2018 and shall be valid for a period of one year i.e. up to 31st March, 2019 and may be extended for a further period of 1 more year, upon review and feedback received from the students and NIRF/NAAC rating. Upon termination of this MOU, each Party agrees to return all intellectual properties including Confidential Information shared with it by the other Party under the terms of this Agreement.

#### 6. ARBITRATION

All disputes arising between the parties to the contract as to the interpretation, operation, or effect of any clause in this deed or any other difference arising between the parties, which cannot be mutually resolved, shall be referred to the office of the Secretary HE, Ministry of Human Resource Development for resolving of dispute by way of Arbitration. The Secretary HE, Ministry of Human Resource Development, GOI shall act as the Sole Arbitrator. The decision of the arbitrator as defined above shall be binding on the parties.

### 7. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, if any are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind.

### 8. RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

### 9. COSTS OF THE MOU

Each Party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU.



#### 10. Confidential Information

The Parties acknowledge that, in the course of their negotiations under this MOU, it may be necessary for one Party to provide documentation, technical and business information and/or intellectual property, in whatever form recorded (collectively, "Confidential Information"), to the other Party. All Confidential Information provided or disclosed by either Party hereunder shall remain the property of the furnishing party, and shall be held in strict confidence by the receiving Party, unless the furnishing Party otherwise consents in writing or unless disclosure of such Confidential Information is required by the applicable laws. Confidential Information furnished by any Party hereunder

- shall not be reproduced or copied, in whole or in part, by the receiving Party except for use as specifically authorized by this MOU;
- ii. shall, together with any copies thereof, be returned to the disclosing Party, or at the request of the disclosing Party, destroyed, when no longer needed for purposes of this MOU; and
- iii. shall only be disclosed by the receiving Party to its employees who have a need to know such Confidential Information in connection with the performance of this MOU; and who have agreed to comply with the confidentiality obligations set forth herein.
