5) Mark list of the examination.

Members gave following suggestions regarding conduction of examination to curb the objections and hindrance:

a) Students should be informed about their less attendance time to time.

- b) As 90 days teaching in a semester is compulsory and to complete syllabus of the students, extra classes should be taken for the students who are admitted late and who remain absent for genuine reasons. It was also told to keep a due record of such extra classes.
- c) It is advised to take undertaking of adequate attendance in regular and extra classes from the student admitted late in the college.
- d) Regarding detention of the student it is advised to issue at least 3 letters before detention.
- e) It is advised to frame a disciplinary committee and rules for foul practices (unfair means) during the examination.
- Recommend to the Governing Body regarding proposals for starting the new programmes:

Chairman Dr. Om Mahodaya proposed to start following certificate courses in the college. Head of the concerned department gave brief information about the course to be started. It has been discussed in the council that there should not be overlapping of time between certificate course and regular theory and practical classes of college. After thorough discussion it was decided to recommend these courses to the Governing Body for further procedure.

1. Confirmation of the minutes of previous meeting held on 28th March 2018 :

After detailed discussion on paper pattern, marking scheme, prevailing exam patterns in various universities and need & justification for one paper instead of two in science subjects at UG level, the minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on 28th March 2018 were passed unanimously by the members.

2. Approval to the revision of course outline, exam pattern and curriculum.

Revision of course outline, exam pattern and curriculum as recommended by the Board of studies of various subjects is accepted unanimously by academic council members.

3. Approval to the panel of Question-paper-setters, answer-paper-evaluators and moderators appointed by Board of studies in the meeting held on 28/07/2018.

The panel of Question-paper-setters, answer-paper-evaluators and moderators appointed by Board of studies in the meeting held on 28/07/2018 is approved by the academic council.

4. Discussion on results of B.Sc. Sem II and M.Sc. Sem. II

Academic council noted the results of the examinations of B.Sc. I year Sem II and M.Sc. (Botany, Chemistry, Microbiology, Zoology) I year Sem II as per following.

5. Revaluation criteria for B.Sc. and M.Sc. examinations.

Chairman Dr. Om Mahodaya informed the meeting that the college is following the prevailing revaluation criteria as per Nagpur University i.e. change is accepted only when the changed marks are more than equal to 10%. As the paper of Nagpur University are of 40 marks, students get benefit when change is of minimum 4 marks but in the present system of the colleges papers are of 100 marks and student need minimum 10 marks difference for change in marks. Hence to reduce this gap, 5% change in marks for revaluation is proposed and accepted by the academic council unanimously.

Chairman also informed that in the present system of autonomy in this college all the students are shown their answersheets after valuation to maintain the transparency. On this Dr. Malpe suggested to replace the *revaluation* word by *grievance redressal mechanism* as the queries of the students are solved on spot by the concerning teacher.

6. Recommendation for proposal for new courses (M.Sc. in Mathematics, Comp. Sci.):

Looking to the demand of the students towards M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Sc. Computer Science, council permitted for initiating procedure to start new courses in M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Sc. Computer Science.

7. Approval to online Spoken Tutorial from IIT (ST-IIT).

Dr. P.A. Saudagar informed the council that college is providing the online Spoken Tutorial of IIT Bombay to the students of B.Sc. II year students. Dr. Mahodaya informed the council regarding the seminar / group projects for the undergraduate students. Same has been included in college timetable as additional activity. Council appreciated the imitative taken by the college looking to the need of the hour. Dr. Mahodaya explained

the timeline of activity (Academic Calendar) to the council for the various events run in the college. Council noted the same.

8. Recommend to the Governing Body for scholarship, fellowship, prizes and medals and to frame regulations for the award of the same.

Dr. Patrikar suggested that there should be Gold medal for the topper for each degree course. Council also suggested to have sponsored prizes for the subjectwise topper in each course. All the members collectively agreed for the same and decided to forward the proposal to the Governing Body of the College.

9. Any other point with the permission of chairman.

(i) Internal valuation for the supplementary examination held in Winter 2018 for Undergraduate and Post Graduate courses.

Chairman proposed the evaluation of the answesheets of Winter 2018 examination by the faculty members of the college i.e. internal evaluation of undergraduate and postgraduate courses. Council approved the proposal.

(ii) Regarding implementation of newly designed courses as part of the curriculum.

Dr. P.A. Saudagar informed the council that RUSA has requested to incorporate newly designed courses under the the identified verticals as part of the curriculum as electives under choise-based credit system or as add-on courses for the purpose of improving the employability of the undergraduate and postgraduate students in Maharashtra. 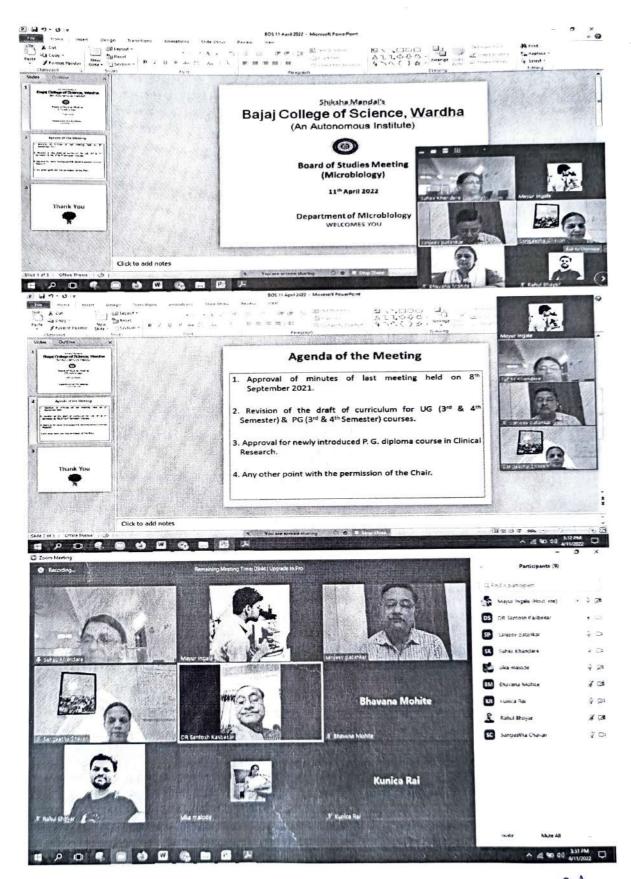
