[REGARDING CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION OF WINTER 2021 FOR REGULAR STUDENTS 0F ODD SEMESTERS OF ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES AND EXSTUDENTS WITH BACKLOG 0F FAILED SUBJECTS 0F ALL PREVIOUS SEMESTERS 0F ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES IN THE WAKE OF COVID-19] REFERENCES:

Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

Bajaj College of Science, Wardha has been granted Autonomy by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the RTM Nagpur University w.e.f. the 2017-18 session. As an autonomous college, the college is mandated to conduct all its semester end examinations including the terminal semester end examinations as per the University Grants Commission. (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018.

Accordingly, the college conducted the semester-end examinations of its various autonomous UG & PG Programmes in Winter 2017, Summer 2018, Winter 2018, Summer 2019, and Winter 2019 as per its own academic regulations which include the scheme of examination.

However, owing to the outbreak of Covid-19 in the country from March 2020 and the ensuing lockdowns etc., the college could not conduct its Winter 2021 examinations of various semesters of UG/PG programmes.

As per the UGC Guidelines April, 2020 and July, 2020; RTM Nagpur University's circular dt. 15.05.2020 regarding Planning of Examinations and Academic Calendar, and Direction No.12 of 2020 regarding Special Rules for the Conduct of Winter 2021 Examinations and Declaration of Results of Regular Students and Promotion of Students to Higher Semesters, the college, issued its own Direction No.3 of 2020 regarding the Declaration of Results of non-terminal Semesters (IInd & IVth Semesters) in the wake of situation resulting out of Covid-19.

Subsequently, the college declared results of all non-terminal semesters of its various UG/PG programmes i.e. (IInd & IVth Semesters) of UG programmes and IInd Semesters of the PG programmes as per the scheme outlined in its own Direction No. 1 of 2020.

However, the Terminal/Final Semester examinations of the TWO autonomous post-graduate programmes of M.Sc which were required to be conducted y the college in Summer 2021 could not be conducted due to the Covid-19 situation.

Subsequently, Director of Higher Education, Government of Maharashtra vide letter no. UNI/2020 Baithak/Vishi-1/5640-A dt. 03.09.2020 directed all the non-agricultural universities and vides its Direction No. 20 of 2020 outlined Special Rules for the Conduct of Summer 2020 Examinations for Regular/Ex-Students of Final year/Semester of Various Programmes/Courses and Examination of their Backlog Subjects/Papers/and Incidental Matters.

Accordingly, the RTM Nagpur University vide its circular dt. 08.09.2020 gave specific instructions regarding the conduct of Practical/Assignment/Workshop/Project/ Dissertation Examinations and vide its Direction No.20 of 2020 outlined Special Rules for the Conduct of Summer 2020 Examinations for Regular/Ex-students of Final Year/ Semester of various Programmes/Courses and Examination of their Backlog Subjects/Papers/and Incidental Matters.

Accordingly, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, being an autonomous college, and as such mandated to conduct its own examinations in consonance with the various guidelines/instructions issued by the UGC, State Government and the RTM Nagpur University from time to time, issued its own Direction # 3 for conducting of Winter 2021.

Examinations of regular students of terminal semesters of its autonomous UG & PG programmes and conducted the said examinations as per the given schedules and declared their results too.

Further, as per the Direction #1 of 2021, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha conducted its Winter 2021 Examinations of students of 1st, 3rd & 5th semesters (of both UG& PG programmes) having a backlog of failed subjects could not be held. In previous semester in the wake of COVID-19 on the above lines i.e. examination of two hours duration for every subject/course of every programme adopting an MCQ pattern & Descriptive on LMS (Gnomio MOODLE).

Now it is certain that the Covid-19 situation is not improving, and offline examinations of full-length duration are not going to be possible in near future. Further, it is to be noted that the Semesters End Examinations of Semesters I, III & V of the UG programmes and Semester III of PG programmes, supposed to be conducted in Winter 2021, have long become overdue and they need to be taken in keeping with the UGC's academic calendar as detailed in the UGC Guidelines September 2020.

Thus in order to both restore stake-holders' faith in Examination System and its credibility which is best explicit in the off line examinations but which cannot be unfortunately held, an alternative of online but full length examination without MCQ's now appears to be the best option especially because all students have become well-versed with the technological part of online teaching learning and online examinations. Examination of two hours duration for every subject/course of every programme adopting an MCQ pattern & Descriptive on LMS (Gnomio MOODLE). in view of the Covid-19 situation.

Accordingly, this special Direction called the DIRECTION REGARDING CONDUCT OF EXAMIANTION OF WINTER-2021 FOR REGULAR STUDENTS OF ALL ODD SEMESTERS OF ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES AND EX-STUDENTS WITH BACKLOG OF FAILED SUBJECTS OF ALL PREVIOUS SEMESTERS OF ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES IN THE WAKE OF COVID-19 is being issued by Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

- 1. This Direction shall be applicable to the regular students of all Odd semesters of UG and PG programmes as well as to the ex-students with a backlog of failed subjects of all previous semesters of all UG and PG programmes conducted in the college under autonomy for their Semester-End examinations.
- 2. The examination of each course/subject, including practical examination/viva voce etc. whatever applicable, shall be conducted through online mode.
- 3. Examination forms of students appearing for these examinations shall be invited through online mode.
- 4. Students shall pay online the stipulated examination fees.

- 5. The duration of theory examination of each course/subject shall be of two hours duration for every subject/course of every programme adopting an MCQ pattern & Descriptive on LMS (Gnomio MOODLE). As per the original Scheme of Examination as detailed in the Academic Regulations of the respective programme,.
- 6. For each theory examination, Question Paper shall be that of 80 marks (or 40 marks wherever applicable) as per the Original Pattern as detailed in the Academic Regulations of the respective programmes.
- 7. The Preliminary Examinations, which are the part of the Internal Assessment mechanism, of all regular students of all programmes shall also be conducted in the above manner.
- 8. The internal Assessment (for 20 marks) shall be carried out as detailed in the Academic Regulations of the respective programmes.
- 9. In view of the Covid-19 situation, even those students who fail to attend the minimum attendance criteria of 75% attendance shall be allowed t appear in examination subject to the condition that they shall attain the prescribed attendance criteria in the next semester whether in online mode or offline mode. However, they shall not be entitled to any marks for attendance which is the parft of Internal Assessment.
- 10. Internal Assessment marks scored by ex-students in their earlier semesters as per the existing scheme of Internal Assessment would r remain unchanged.
- 11. The Preliminary Examination for all regular students of all Odd Semesters (wherever applicable) and also for the ex-students shall be conducted tentatively in the Fourth Week of March 2021.
- 12. The results shall be declared within 45 days from the end f Semester End Examiantion. The valuation/moderation of the answer books shall be done through both offline and online mode depending on the Covvid-19 situation.
- 13. On the day of examination as per the notified time table, the examinees for Semester-End Examinations would be sent a Gnomio MOODLE link of question paper of then given Subject on their registered mobile number via WhatsApp 10 minutes before the scheduled start of the examination. The examinees would be required to solve answers in their own and legible handwriting on a good quality ruled (line) paper of A-4 size leaving a margin of 1.5 inch on the left side. It may be noted that if examinees are found to have copied their answers from books or any other source the same shall be treated as "unfair means" and due action including debarment from examination shall be taken against the concerned examinees. After expiry of the examination duration (Two Hours), students would send the PDF files of their answer papers to the given Gnomio MOODLE link within 30 minutes from the expiry of the duration of examination. Students failing to submit their papers within 30 minutes shall be marked as ABSENT and no excuse whatsoever shall be entertained. Students are also required to preserve their hand-written answer-sheets/papers and submit them to the college whenever they are back in college.
- 14. Any other instructions/guidelines with respect to the conduct of Winter 2021 Examinations of regular students of odd semesters and also the ex-students with a backlog of failed subjects in previous semesters received from the UGC, State Government and RTM Nagpur University after the issuance of this Direction shall be deemed to be incorporated in this Direction as long as such instructions/guidelines are not inconsistent with the college's mandate of conducting its

- own examinations under autonomy or the University Grants Commission (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018.
- 15. This Direction being a one-off and special direction necessitated by the Covid-19 situation shall be operative only for the purpose and period for which it has come into existence and presently only for the purpose of the conduct of Summer 2021 Examinations of regular students of UG/PG programmes and ex-students with a backlog of failed subjects in previous semesters. Further, the Semester End Examination of the First Semester of M.Sc shall be conducted in the above manner as a part of Winter 2021 Examination unless they are held in offline mode is possible in due course of time. Further, if the Covid-19 situation does not improve, the Summer 2021 Examinations shall also be conducted in the above manner without the issuance of any fresh Direction.
- 16. This Direction has been approved by the college's Academic Council and the Governing Body.
