[REGARDING CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION OF SUMMER 2021 FOR STUDENTS OF EVEN SEMESTER OF ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES WITH A BACKLOG OF FAILED SUBJECTS IN PREVIOUS SEMESTERS IN THE WAKE OF COVID--19]

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Bajaj College of Science, Wardha has been granted Autonomy by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the RTM Nagpur University w.e.f. the 2017-18 session. As an autonomous college, the college is mandated to conduct all its semester-end examinations including the terminal semester-end examinations as per the University Grants Commission (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018.

Accordingly, the college conducted the semester-end examinations of its various autonomous UG & PG Programmes in Winter 2017, Summer 2018, Winter 2018, Summer 2019, and Winter 2019 as per its own academic regulations which include the scheme of examination.

However, owing to the outbreak of Covid-19 in the country from March 2020 and the ensuing lockdowns etc., the college could not conduct its Summer 2021 examinations of various semesters of UG & PG programmes.

As per the UGC Guidelines April, 2020 and July, 2020; RTM Nagpur University's circular dt. 15.05.2020 regarding Planning of Examinations and Academic Calendar, and Direction No.12 of 2020 regarding Special Rules for the Conduct of Summer 2021 Examinations and Declaration of Results of Regular Students and Promotion of Students to Higher Semesters, the college, issued its own Direction No.3 of 2020 regarding the Declaration of Results of non-terminal Semesters (IInd & IVth Semesters) in the wake of situation resulting out of covid-19.

Subsequently, the college declared result of all semester of its various UG/PG programmes i.e. IInd & IVth semester of UG Programmes and the IInd & IVth semester of PG programmes as per the scheme outlined in its own Direction No. 3 of 2020.

Subsequently, Director of Higher Education, Government of Maharashtra vide letter No.UNI/2020/Baithak/Vishi-1/5640-A dt. 03/09/2020 directed all the non-agricultural universities in Maharashtra to conduct examinations of the final year/semester of various academic programmes within specified time period.

Accordingly, the RTM Nagpur University vide its circular dt. 08.09.2020 gave specific instructions regarding the conduct of Practical/Assignment/Workshop/Project/ Dissertation Examinations and vide its Direction No.20 of 2020 outlined Special Rules for the Conduct of Summer 2020 Examinations for Regular/Ex-students of Final Year/ Semester of various Programmes/Courses and Examination of their Backlog Subjects/Papers/and Incidental Matters.

Accordingly, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, being an autonomous college, and as such mandated to conduct its own examinations in consonance with the various

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guidelines/instructions issued by the UGC, State Government and the RTM Nagpur University from time to time, issued its own Direction # 3 for conducting of Summer 2020.

Examinations of regular students of terminal semesters of its autonomous UG & PG programmes and conducted the said examinations as per the given schedules and declared their results too.

Further, owing to the continuance of Covid-19 situation and related restrictions, the Summer 2021 Examinations of students of non-terminal semesters (of both UGPG programmes) having a backlog of failed subjects could not be held.

As per its Direction # 32 of 2020 and Circular dated 19.12.2020, the RTM Nagpur University has notified its procedures/modalities for conducting Summer 2021 Examinations of Failure Students of all Semesters and External Students As per Direction, 2020 through offline/online/mixed mode.

Being an Autonomous college, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, too, sought from the concerned students/parents their preferences/consent for online or offline mode for the Summer 2021 examination.

However, the majority of students (about 95%) expressed their willingness to report to the college for offline examination and preferred an online mode of examination.


Accordingly, this special Direction called as DIRECTION CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION OF SUMMER 2021 FOR REGULAR STUDENTS OF B.Sc. AND M.Sc PROGRAMMES INCLUDING EXAMINATIONS OF BACKLOG COURSES/SUBJECTS OF THESE STUDENTS IN THE WAKE OF COVID-19 is being issued.

1. This Direction shall be applicable to the regular students of all UG & PG programmes who have some backlog of failed subjects of earlier previous semesters.
2. The examination of each course/subject, including practical examination/viva voce etc. wherever applicable, of these programmes shall be conducted through online mode.
3. Examination forms of students appearing for these Examinations shall be invited through online mode.
4. Students shall pay online the stipulated examination fees.
5. Students shall be given the link of online examination on their registered mobile phone 10 minutes before the commencement of examination on the date of examination.
6. The duration of theory examination of each course/subject shall be that of only ONE HOUR.
7. Each question paper of each examination shall consist of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ's) only.

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8. Each question paper shall have 50 MCQ's covering all different units of the syllabus out of which students shall have to attempt any 40 MCQ's. In case students attempt more than 40 MCQ's, only the first 40 MCQ's with correct responses shall be assessed.
9. Each MCQ shall carry 02 Marks.
10. Thus the theory paper of each Semester End Examination (External Assessment) shall be that of 80 Marks.
11. The Internal Assessment marks obtained by students earlier shall remain unchanged.
12. The results shall be declared in time.
13. Any other instructions/guidelines issued by the UGC, State Government and the RTM Nagpur University after the issuance of this Direction with respect to the conduct of Summer 2020 Examinations of regular students of autonomous UG & PG programmes with a backlog of failed subjects in previous semesters, shall be deemed to be incorporated in this Direction with respect to the conduct of Summer 2021 Examination of regular students of autonomous UG/PG programmes with a backlog of failed subjects in previous semesters, shall be deemed to be incorporated in this Direction as long as such instructions/guidelines are not inconsistent with the college's mandate of conducting its own examinations under autonomy or the University Grants Commission (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018.
14. This Direction being a one-off and special direction necessitated by the Covid-19 situation shall be operative only for the purpose and period for which it has come into existence and presently only for the purpose of the conduct of Summer 2021 Examinations of regular students of non-terminal semesters with a backlog of failed subjects in previous semesters of autonomous UG/PG programmes in the college.
15. This Direction has been approved by the college's Academic Council and the Governing Body.
16. This Direction shall not be applicable to those students who have already appeared in the Terminal Semester examinations of PG programmes of M.Sc in Summer 2021 as the college Direction. These students, if having any backlog of failed subjects, shall appear for their Supplementary Examination in Winter 2020 whenever it is held in whichever mode i.e. either online or offline mode.
