District Level Poster Competition at Bajaj College of Science, Wardha

Bajaj College of Science, Wardha, in association with the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Directorate of Higher Education {Govt. of Maharashtra} organized Y20 District Level Poster Competition & Workshop on the theme "Future of Work: Industry 4.0, Innovation and 21st century skills".

On the occasion Prof. Sanjay Thakare, Joint Director of Higher Education, Nagpur Division was the Chief Guest, whereas Dr. Narendra Kanhe, Principal, Bajaj Institute of Technology was the guest speaker while Shri Sanjay Bhargava, Chairman, Shiksha Mandal, Wardha presided over the program.
