

**A Report of
“Innovative Idea/Start-Up” Competition”
held at Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.**

Maharashtra Student Innovation Challenge is an initiative to hunt young entrepreneurs and support them with possible support to achieve their start-up dreams. Under above theme, An Innovative idea/Start-up competition was organised by **RICH CLUB** in association with **Institute Innovation Council (IIC)** and **Department of Chemistry**, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha in September 2023. Under this competition, students were asked to register either as an individual or in team (of maximum three members) and submit their idea along with PPT. After scrutiny, final presentations on power point were conducted on **9th October 2023 at 11:00 am** in Department of Chemistry, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha. Dr. Pradip V. Tekade, Principal of the college inaugurated the competition by his introductory remark. For this competition, college faculties Dr. Mrs. N. P. Mohabansi, Dr. D. D. Naik, Dr. Ms. B. V. Mohite worked as jury members. While, the whole event was coordinated by Dr. P. G. Borkar, Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Bajaj College of Science Wardha.

Total 25 students were registered and submitted their idea for this event. Total 16 novel ideas were received, out of which 8 ideas were from individual category and 8 ideas were from team category. During competition, students presented their innovative ideas in the frontier areas of science like chemistry, life-sciences, electronics, computer science etc. All the presentations were offline and were taken on power point. 3. Disha R. Sojrani, Sai P. Dhumane (3rd Prize)



