

Agenda 3 of Academic Council dated 28/07/2023:

Approval to the PG NEP credit structure, regulations/directions and Syllabi to be implemented from the academic session 2023-24

Meetings of various Boards of Studies were conducted by the departments in the months of May and June 2023 to approve the NEP Credit Structure and to revise the syllabi of PG programmes as per NEP 2020 and the directions of State Govt. vide GR dated May 16th, 2023. The college has prepared the NEP structure, syllabi and the regulations for PG.

The Academic Council approved the NEP credit structure, syllabi (Annexure 3) and regulations/directions of PG programme (Annexure 4) to be implemented from the academic session 2023-24. Governing body approved the NEP Credit Structure, syllabi and Regulations / Directions of PG programme recommended by Academic Council.

Agenda 4 of Academic Council dated 28/07/2023:

Second and Final Year admissions to all the students of B. Sc. I and II (Session 2022-23) due to NEP2020 implementation from the academic session 2023-24

College has implemented NEP 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 to the first years of UG and PG programs. Therefore, it would be impractical to conduct classes for non NEP students who could not get admissions in the second and final year of B.Sc. in the academic session 2023-24. So, Board of Examination of the college has decided to give carry-on to all the students of B.Sc I and II years to the higher classes to avoid the academic loss of the students.

It was requested to the members of the council to accord approval to the decision of Board of Examination

The Academic Council approved the decision of the Board of Examination in the better interest of the students. Governing body also approved the above cited decision of Board of Examination recommended by Academic Council.

Agenda 3 : Approval to the formation of statutory bodies

Prof. P.V. Tekade informed the members of Governing Body that the three-year tenure of the statutory bodies of the Autonomy ended in 2022-23. College has received the nominees of RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur for Governing Body, Academic Council, Finance Committee and all the Board of studies. Name of the members from the management for Governing Body received. However, the State Government Nominee and UGC nominee for Governing Body is yet to receive.

Prof. Tekade requested Governing Body to nominate four experts/academicians from outside the college representing such areas as Industry, Commerce, Law, Education, Medicine, Engineering, Sciences etc. on Academic Council of the College. Prof. P.V. Tekade informed the Governing Body that college received the Autonomous Status from the session 2017-18. College has completed two terms of statutory bodies and now this is the third term of statutory bodies. From this year as per the new guideline of Autonomy tenure of the Governing body is increased to five years. Previously it was of three years only.

Chairman, Shri. Sanjay Bhargava informed the Governing Body about the result of NAAC accreditation. College received B++ grade with CGPA 2.93. He advised to make a meticulous planning and efforts to improve the grade in next cycle of accreditation.






B.Sc. Final Year Examination Results (Summer Examination - Regular Students)




B.Sc. Final Year Examination Results (Winter Examination Failure students)




M.Sc. Botany Final Year Examination Results (Summer Examination - Regular Students)




M.Sc. Botany Final Year Examination Results (Winter Examination - Failure Students)




M.Sc. Chemistry Final Year Examination Results (Summer Examination - Regular Students)




M.Sc. Chemistry Final Year Examination Results (Winter Examination - Failure Students)




M.Sc. Microbiology Final Year Examination Results (Summer Examination - Regular Students)




M.Sc. Microbiology Final Year Examination Results (Winter Examination - Failure Students)




M.Sc. Zoology Final Year Examination Results (Summer Examination - Regular Students)




M.Sc. Zoology Final Year Examination Results (Winter Examination - Failure Students)




Dr. Sahu suggested to invite retired Professors from University/ Private Institutions like D.Y. Patil, Pune to teach for PG so that results could be improved.
