#### Welcome of Members of BOS.

Dr. Mrs. U.A. Malode welcomed all members of BOS and also extends her gratitude to all the members of BOS in Microbiology subject, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

### 2. Approval of minutes of last meeting held on 11th April 2022

Dr. Mrs. U. A. Malode read out the minutes of the last meeting of BOS held on 11th April 2022 and requested all committee members for the approval of it. All BOS members approved the minutes of last BOS meeting held on 11th April 2022.

# 3. Discussion on UG and PG curriculum framing/modification (III and IV Semester)

Dr. Mrs. U. A. Malode has mentioned that the revised curriculum which has been prepared in last BOS meeting held on 11th April 2022 was shared to BOS members and she asked the members, if any revision is required in it. All BOS members, Dr. Patankar, Dr. Rahul Bhoyar agreed that no further revision is required in the updated PG curriculum. Prof. Chavan through email put a query about that there was no topic "development and maturation of B and T cells" in syllabus of semester V of unit V. She mentioned to add latest edition of reference books in the reference list. But both queries were already fulfilled in the revised syllabus.

Dr. Malode mentioned that in semester III Unit V Enzymology need some rearrangement of the topic. Hence Dr. Patankar has suggested combination of some topics from A and B part under heading of "General concepts/ terminologies in Enzymology" Dr. Bhoyar has also agreed with the suggestions. In Unit VI Vitamins, addition of Recommended Dietary Allowances, absorption, sources of vitamin have been suggested by Dr. Malode and Dr. Patankar. All BOS members agreed with the addition of these points.

In Semester V, Dr. Bhoyar suggested to add at least single example of DNA and RNA viruses each in the unit 1 of semester V. Dr. S. D. Patankar suggested to add life cycle of Plasmodium in unit 1 of semester V syllabus. He also suggested to incorporate fungal disease 'superficial mycosis'. Dr. Malode put a query regarding flow of content during teaching immunology, so in Unit V, Dr. Patankar suggested to shift topic 'organs of immune system' at the beginning of unit V followed by antigen and immunoglobulin.

As we have to follow the guidelines of RTMNU, it is decided in meeting to wait for the final draft frame by RTMNU.
