- [4] Following the guidelines of Maharashtra Govt Latest GR Dt. 20 Apr 2023 regarding NEP, we have made few changes in our earlier UG structure. PG syllabus and NEP scheme has been framed.
- [5] Courses in Various categories with credit system and teaching scheme for B.Sc. Sem-I to Sem-VIII are proposed. It is as given in **Appendix-1**. Baskets of Minors, Electives, GE/OE, VSEC, IKS are also mentioned therein.
