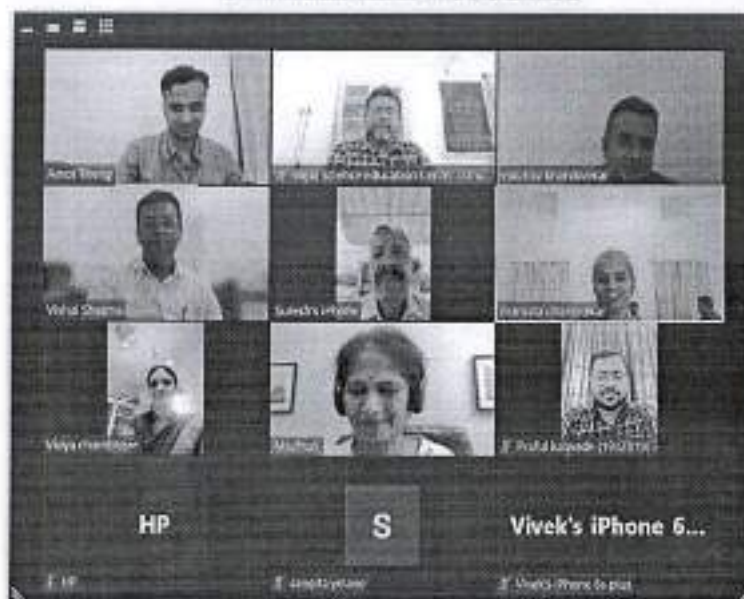
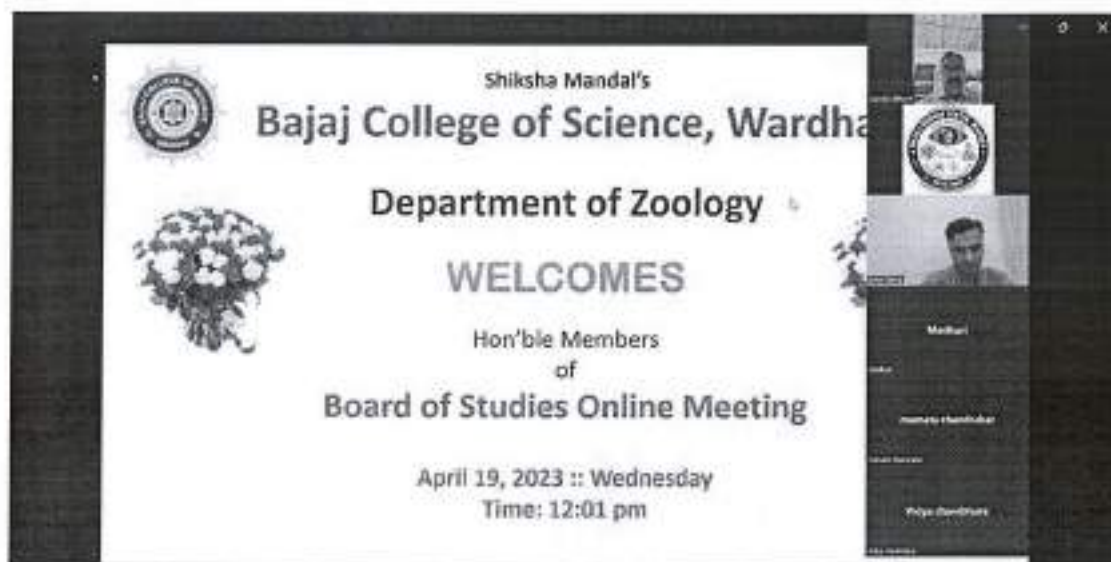

- 3) Syllabus design as per NEP 2020 for Sem I and Sem II of B.Sc. starting from session 2023-24: the syllabus for Major Zoology , minor Zoology , electives offered by Zoology, GE, SEC with few suggestions in GE the syllabus has been approved.
- 4) It has also been mentioned by Dr. M.R.Chandrakar that these proposed plans and syllabus are subject to changes as per the directions of Govt. of Maharashtra and parent university RTM Nagpur University so that it would be parallel to the university plans.
- 5) Scheme of examination for on UG Sem I and Sem II : it has been mentioned that till 19th April , 2023 no Scheme of examination for on UG Sem I and Sem II has been proposed by the university. Hence it is decided if no change has been suggested by the university then the existing plan of examination will be continued for major and minor papers.
- 6) Any other point with permission of the Chair: introduced two new PG faculties

- 7) Praful Kalwade and Sangita Yelane to the panel. They have been congratulated by the panel.
- 8) The meeting ended with expressing sincere thanks to the members by SH. V.P. Khandwekar.
- 9) In the Bos meeting dated 19th April, 2023; plan and syllabus to be implemented from the academic session 2022-23 under the NEP 2020 has been discussed. It has been mentioned that it was a tentative plan and could be changed as per the directions of GOM and RTMNU. As per the GoM GR dated 20th April; 2023 and directions by RTMNU dated 26th April, 2023 following changes have been made--in the meeting dated 19th April, 2023 ; we had a discussion on major, minor, and elective papers to be offered in UG and Skill enhanced courses, GE courses.

As per the guidelines Skill enhanced courses have to be of practical only so we have made the changes accordingly. In addition to this in B.Sc. Sem I and Sem III students of Zoology Major have to opt for VSC/Vocational Skill Enhancement Course consisting of practicals only .We had proposed Tools and techniques in Zoology I and II. The changes and syllabus has been circulated and approved by circulation on 9th May; 2023 through Email. The approved scheme is as follows:-
