Minutes of the BOS meeting held on 11/10/2023 at 12.00 noon

The meeting of the board of studies in languages was held on 11/10/2023 at 12.00 noon in Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

01. The minutes of the previous meeting dated 20/04/2023 were discussed and confirmed.
02. Miss. Sangita Khode discussed the revised syllabus and question paper pattern of Marathi as per NEP with subject expert Dr. Rajesh Deshpande which he approved.
03. Miss. Surekha Dubey discussed the revised syllabus and question paper pattern of Hindi as per NEP with subject expert Dr. Anilkumar Dubey which he approved.
04. All the experts were not happy with the marking scheme of just 35 marks for theory in all the Languages.
05. Shri R K Thombare shared a chart showing distribution of credits as per NEP. He explained to all the experts that there are 2.0 credits for compulsory English and 2.0 credits for supplementary English, Marathi and Hindi.
06. All the three experts in English suggested that , there should be a word limit of 100 words instead of 120 words in Long –answer question, and 50 words instead of 60 in case of Short-answer question, having same weightage of marks.
07. Dr. Kannake suggested that instead of summarizing in unit 3, some topic like goal setting, team spirit or leadership trait may be given for write –up in 50 words for 03 marks. Other experts consented for the same.
08. Dr. Dubey suggested that NEP syllabus should include LOCF framework.
09. Shri. R. K. Thombare & all the experts unanimously decided that syllabus of Supplementary English which is for sem III & sem IV will be discussed in the next meeting with course outcomes.
10. All the experts gave their consent for syllabus & pattern of NEP 2020.
11. The experts consented the names of Prof. Milind Shende, Prof. Satish Manwar as paper setters and valuers.
12. The experts suggested that new certificate courses may be started with the availability of CHB teacher.

As there was no other matter on the agenda, the meeting came to an end.
