

### "POCSO Act at School and Colleges"

on 21st July 2023

### REPORT

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), Women's Cell, Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell, Grievance Redressal Committee, and Centre for Women Studies and Services (CWSS) of Bajaj College of Science, Wardha jointly conducted a Workshop on "POCSO Act at School and Colleges" for undergraduate and postgraduate students on Friday, 21st July 2023 at 03:00 pm in Gandhi Memorial Hall, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha.

The resource persons for the workshop were Shri. Vivek Deshmukh, Secretary, District Legal Aid Services Authority, Wardha and Civil Judge Senior Level, Advocate Anita Thakare, Vice President, District Bar Association, Wardha, Mrs. Reshma Raghatate, Central Administration, Sakhi- One Stop Center, Wardha, and Mrs. Madhuri Waghade, Assistant Police Officer, Bharosa Cell, Office of the Superintendent of Police, Wardha.

The workshop started with welcoming the distinguished guests by Prof. P.V. Tekade, Officiating Principal, Bajaj College of Science, Wardha. Dr. Mrs. S.S. Khandare, Programme Officer, Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) and Women's Cell gave introductory speech. Firstly, Mrs. Reshma Raghatate, Central Administration, Sakhi- One Stop Center, Wardha guided the students about POCSO Act, 2012 and appealed the students to prevent and protect themselves from any cases of sexual abuse.

Mrs. Madhuri Waghade, Assistant Police Officer, Bharosa Cell, Office of the Superintendent of Police, Wardha guided the students that in case of any incidents of sexual abuse and sexual harassment they should approach their parents, friends and family and the police for help. She made students aware about how to contact the police, type of complaints and how to lodge complaint. She also shared important helpline numbers with the students and how to contact them and seek help in case of emergency.

Also, Advocate Anita Thakare, Vice President, District Bar Association, Wardha created awareness among the students about the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 and provisions under this act. She told the importance of this act which aims to protect the children from offences of sexual assault and sexual harassment and provide establishment of special courts for trails of such offences.

Moreover, Shri. Vivek Deshmukh, Secretary, District Legal Aid Services Authority, Wardha and Civil Judge Senior Level inspired the students to be self-aware, to have self-control and be self-motivated. He appealed the students to keep themselves away from any negative thoughts, stay positive and prevent themselves from any misconduct and lawbreaking. He guided the students about how the POCSO Act 2012 provides a strong legal framework for protecting children from sexual abuse and exploitation.

The program was compared by Dr. M.A. Haque, Programme Officer, CWSS and Dr. M.M. Yerpude proposed the vote of thanks. The workshop was attended by 102 students (undergraduate and postgraduate students) and faculty members.

Prof. Pradip Tekade, Principal, Bajaj College of Science inaugurated the Screening Camp. Dr. S.S. Khandare, HOD, Department of Microbiology, Mr. P.B. Bhoyar and Dr. M.G.
