These cells work towards creating a more equitable and inclusive society through comprehensive support systems, awareness programs, and policy implementation. Addressing the challenges and strengthening the efforts of SC/ST cells can significantly enhance their effectiveness and contribute to the overall development of SC/ST communities.

Aims and Objectives:
