
### MINUTES OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

## Agenda 1:

## Confirmation of the minutes of previous meeting held on 04/04/2024.

The minutes of the meeting held on 04/04/2024 were already circulated among the members. No suggestions or modifications were received from the members; all the members unanimously confirmed the minutes of the Academic Council meeting dated 04/04/2024.

# Agenda 2 : Approval to the minutes of BoS meetings held in the month of August 2024

Member Secretary Dr. Saudagar informed the house that the meetings of the Boards of Studies including interdisciplinary board of all the subjects were held during 26<sup>th</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2024 and 17<sup>th</sup> September 2024 to approve the syllabi of Sem V & VI (Sem III and IV for Computer Science and Biotechnology), Electives, Major, Minor, VSC, SEC and GE/OE. Also to approve the panel of examiners for Summer 2025 exam and SOP and guidelines for Field Projects / Internship. (Annexure I)

## Agenda 3: Approval to the minutes of Board of Examination meetings.

Controller of Examination Dr. Mrs. N.P. Mohabansi briefed the council that the meetings of the Board of Examination were held on 19/06/2024, 28/06/2024 and 06/08/2024. In those meetings Board of Examination approved the following -

- a) guidelines for adoption of Non-NEP students in new NEP 2020 scheme,
- b) the scheme of continuous internal assessment for project of M.Sc. Sem II and Sem IV under new NEP 2020,
- c) Eligibility for awards and medals,
- d) Tabulation register of B.Sc. Sem VI Winter 2024 supplementary examination.

# Agenda 4: Dispose off old answer sheets of the exams conducted under Autonomy.

Member Secretary informed the house that since 2017, under autonomy, the college has conducted several examinations and stored the valued/moderated answer books safely. But, now because of space constraints, the old answer books need to be disposed off. This will create additional space for the forthcoming examinations answer sheets / material.

The Controller of Examination Dr. Mrs. N.P. Mohabansi read out the policy (Annexure III) for disposing the old anser sheets. The Principal of the college informed the house about reuse of the paper after recycling in the form of paper bags, files, envelopes, etc. The member appreciated the initiative and efforts of the college.

Members noted the information and permitted the COE and Principal of the college to discard the valued answer sheets upto Summer 2023 examination.

## Agenda 5 : Regarding starting M.Sc. Physics course.

The college had applied to start M.Sc. Physics programme from the academic session 2024-25. The college received permission from the State government on 15/07/2024 and obtained the first affiliation for this course on 21/08/2024 (Annexure IV) from the parent university. The main condition specified in the said government resolution is to have a minimum of 50% admissions, which is equivalent to 11 admissions. The B.Sc. final year result of the college was announced on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2024, while the results of the B.Sc. Final year of RTM Nagpur University were declared on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2024. Since we received the first affiliation on 21st August 2024, the interested students for M.Sc. Physics had already taken admissions or completed admission process in other institutions. As a result, we anticipate only 2 to 3 admissions this year. Therefore, we recommended to commence this program from the academic session 2025-26. Meeting noted the information and granted permission to commence M.Sc. Physics program from the academic session 2025-26. Dr. Khaparde, member of the council advised to utilize the time for promotion of M.Sc. Physics program to raise the number of applications.

### Agenda 6: Field project guidelines and SOP approval

Dr. P.A. Saudagar, Member Secretary informed the meeting that as per NEP 2020, the students of Sem IV and V have to undergo field projects and in Sem V they have internship. So, to facilitate Field Projects and Internships, college has prepared the guidelines and operating procedure for the same. These documents are already been approved by all Board of Studies.

Shri. N.A. Barwat, Assistant Professor in Chemistry read the SOP and guidelines for field projects. Dr. Rajesh Khaparde, member of the council suggested few important modifications in the evaluation / marking scheme. Council approved the SOP and guidelines (Annexure V) for field project with modification.
