Strengthening of the placement and internship cell was requested.	The placement and internship cell was strengthened during the academic year by inviting multiple employer organizations such as Allmpus Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Cleanchem Laboratories LLP, IPCA Laboratories, Bajaj Finserv, and Sriram Finance for placements, internships, and career interaction.
Need for civil services and competitive examination books in the library.	Library resources were enhanced with competitive-examination books and updated new-syllabus textbooks.
Suggestions for modern teaching aids, internships, extracurricular science activities, and career guidance	Smart classrooms, RICH Club activities, career counseling sessions, and MoUs for internships were implemented to improve student support.
